

Application Announcement: First Co-operation Visit Between AUD and Babes-Bolyai University, Cluj-Napoca, Romania under the Erasmus Plus Programme.

Applications from AUD faculty members are solicited for a short exploratory visit (approx. 7 days) to Babes-Bolyai University, Cluj-Napoca, Romania during the period late November 2016 through January 2017 (exact dates to be decided).

Ambedkar University Delhi and Babes-Bolyai University, Cluj-Napoca (UBB), Romania entered into an agreement early in 2016 under the ERASMUS Plus programme. Under this agreement there will be multiple 'exchange' visits of faculty, non-teaching staff and students. 'UBB' is the largest university in Romania with a history going back more than four hundred years and its newest incarnation dates to 1959. It offers study programmes in Romanian, Hungarian, German, French and English. UBB is especially interested in short exchange visits of faculty and students active in the behavioural sciences, social sciences and management/ business studies. *The first AUD visit to UBB will involve three faculty delegates selected according to guidelines of the Erasmus Plus programme.* This visit is tentatively scheduled for a period of about 7 days in December of 2016 or January of 2017. Subsequent visits under this agreement shall involve students and non-teaching staff as well as faculty members. **Applicants are encouraged to consult the UBB website to familiarize themselves with the university** (<http://www.ubbcluj.ro/>; click on EN at top of home page). **They may direct any questions to Dr. Santosh Kumar Singh (AUD-UBB programme contact person/co-ordinator): santosh@aud.ac.in.**

UBB will arrange for the AUD faculty delegates to teach classes and interact with the university students, faculty and administration. Erasmus Plus will pay the AUD visitors approximately 900 Euros for a week-long visit, in addition to air travel costs. The guests will be required to take care of their local travel/boarding/lodging etc. out of their honorarium. However, UBB will make arrangement for affordable stay in a local hotel. AUD and UBB will ensure that necessary documents are provided for the issuing of required visas and travel authorization. AUD is likely to cover the visa application costs.

Last date for submission of applications: 18 October 2016. The application should consist of a letter of interest and a CV. It should be provided in hard copy to Dr. Sunita Tyagi, Asst. Registrar (Coordination)/VC Secretariat, AUD.
