MA PSYCHOLOGY (PSYCHOSOCIAL CLINICAL STUDIES)

The following candidate have been provisionally empanelled for admission 2014 under the '**Single Girl Child**' category to the Master of Psychology (Psychosocial Clinical Studies) programme of the School of Human Studies commencing in August 2014, subject to the following conditions:

- 1 They should produce the original Mark sheets relating to the first-degree examination to satisfy the minimum eligibility conditions as prescribed for the programme. **(Original Certificates should be brought- they will be returned after the verification)**
- 2 The candidates should produce relevant documents in support of their age, category certificate, qualifications and marks obtained in various examinations right from school final examination:
 - a. **Photocopy of Mark Sheet and Provisional Certificates of Qualifying examination.** (If result is still to be declared, admission can be taken by signing an undertaking).
 - b. **Photocopies of the 10th and 12th Certificates**
 - c. **Certificate of Reserved Category, if any and proof of NCT category, if applicable.**
- 3 The candidates must submit four (2 stamp-size + 2 passport-size) photographs at the time of payment of fees. The name of the candidate should be written in block letters at the back of the photographs, and submitted in an envelope.
- 4 They should satisfy such other requirements as prescribed by the University.
- 5 The candidates should deposit the required fees at the SHS office, Room No. 60 (AUD, Kashmere Gate) during the following period from **31st July 2014 to 1st August 2014** failing which their admission shall be cancelled.
- 6 The candidate should submit a **Demand Draft of Rs. 28,000/-** in the name of "**Ambedkar University, Delhi**" payable at New Delhi. Cheque/Cash **will not** be accepted in any case.
- 7 **Two anti-ragging affidavits** need to be submitted by the candidates – **one by student and another by Guardian/Parent.** Each affidavit must be printed on a Rs. 10/- non-judicial stamp paper, and the text should conform to the formats available on the university website at the following link: www.aud.ac.in/admissions2014.

- 8 They should satisfy all other requirements as prescribed by the University.
- 9 Candidates who are seeking financial support need to go through the **fee waiver** policy of AUD, which is available on the university website. Such candidates are not required to pay the fee at the time of admission, and should instead submit the fee waiver application form, duly filled, along with documents of income proof, at the time of admission. - 10 Filled in and duly signed **Admission Form** (will be provided at the admission counter).
