IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS APPLYING FOR BVOC

The School of Vocational Studies (SVS), as envisaged, has explored and developed programmes and courses that will provide students with the required academic background and skills-set for meaningful employment once they graduate from the programme. It is hoped that these programmes would enable many of the students to become self-employed, entrepreneurs, creators and generators of job for themselves and for many more educated youth in the society.

The vision of SVS is to impart practical training to its undergraduate students to enable them to pursue full-time or part-time tertiary education. SVS aims to bridge the gap between the skill-profiles of the graduates and those that are required by the industries in the job market. It hopes to create a community of professionals with skills and sound awareness of their social-world.

The vocational programmes offered by SVS during 2017-18 are:

- i. Tourism and Hospitality (T&H)
- ii. Retail Management (RM)
- iii. Early Childhood Centre Management and Entrepreneurship (ECCME)¹

STRUCTURE:

The programme is delivered through a total number of 180 credits over six semesters. Out of the total 180 credits in BVoc, the skill component or skill papers comprise 108 credits and 72 credits in General Education Component.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION:English

ELIGIBILITY: The candidate must have passed the class XII or an equivalent examination from a recognised Board and secured the minimum cut-off marks prescribed by the University.

Total seats: 32 + Supernumerary Seats (offered at Karampura Campus)

FEES:

- (i) In SVS tuition fee will be charged @ Rs.500/- per credit. Therefore, in Semester 1 which has 30 credits the total fee towards tuition fee will be Rs.15,000/-.
- (ii) Additional programme enrichment fees will be charged @ of Rs.1000/- per semester. This is towards industry exposure, special seminars and interactions with industry experts.
- (iii) Student Welfare Fund Rs.500/- per semester.
- (iv) Caution/Security Money of Rs.5000/- refundable on completion of the programme.

¹ECCME does not offer a Certificate programme. In addition, SVS will launch Banking, Financial Services and Insurance later in the Academic Year.

Partial/Full Fee Waiver and scholarships are available. Full fee waiver of tuition fee will be extended to students belonging to SC/ST/PwD categories.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection will be merit based on the basis of the marks obtained in Class XII, which will include any vocational subject (if any). The marksheet must clearly state that it is a vocational subject.

Weightage during admission will be given in the following way:

- i) 65% weightage will be given to 10+2 marks
- ii) 10% weightage will be given to students with class 12 pass with NSQF Level 4/ pass one vocational subject in Class 12th.
- iii) 25% weightage will be for Personal Interviews/ aptitude

Depending upon the number of applicants, the interview list will be prepared which will include tallying together the weightage of marks obtained in Class 12, and the weightage given to the vocational subject. Interviews will take place at the end of June 2017. Candidates can be called for interview in the ratio of 1:4.

Stages for Selection: There will be 2 stages of selection before the final offer for admission is prepared.

Stage-I: Shortlisted qualified candidates will be called for interview based on class 12 marks combined with vocational subject points if any.

Stage-II: Final offer for admission would be based on the cumulative score i.e. Class XII marks; points awarded for vocational subject in class 12 and the interview points.

Reservations norms of Government of NCT of Delhi will apply.
