



## **CERTIFICATE IN TEACHING ENGLISH TO SPEAKERS OF INDIAN LANGUAGES CTESIL**

CTESIL is a three-month Certificate programme in teaching English being launched by the Centre for English Language Education (CELE). The aim of the programme is to prepare a cadre of teachers who can design and teach English proficiency courses to school-level learners. The programme will engage participants in critical, self-reflective, practice based experiences in real classrooms in order to develop language teaching skills in a multilingual context. An important aspect of the programme is its emphasis on practice based learning which is reflected in all the course content and methodology. Therefore, each course has a strong component of practicum to provide hands on experience and exposure to classroom teaching, being made available through English proficiency courses that will be conducted in Delhi government schools. CTESIL is open to all graduates from any disciplines who are interested to learn teaching English and are looking for certification. It is also relevant for practising teachers who wish to upgrade their English language teaching skills.

### **Aims of the programme**

- To prepare graduates with good proficiency for teaching English to learners at secondary/higher secondary level, who may take up English proficiency teaching or explore entrepreneurial opportunities
- To enable participants to develop pedagogical skills and to devise techniques, strategies and means of teaching English proficiency in a multilingual context
- To prepare a potential cadre of trained teachers who may support outreach initiatives of AUD

## **Who can apply?**

- Graduates in any discipline with intermediate level English language proficiency (\*B1 level as per CEFR levels). See below for details of the selection procedure.

## **What is the mode of application?**

Interested candidates should apply online with necessary documents. Log onto [www.aud.ac.in](http://www.aud.ac.in), and click on Announcement Section for online application.

## **Mode of selection**

- A written Proficiency test will be held in AUD Karampura campus on 15<sup>th</sup> of September from 9:30 to 11:30 am
- An oral test/interview will **be conducted on the same day of the Proficiency test unless otherwise indicated**
- The final selection will be based on a combination of scores obtained in graduation (50% for General category applicants and 45% for Reserved category applicants), proficiency test performance and overall indication of interest and commitment displayed during the interview.

**Total number of Seats:** Thirty (30)

**Programme duration and credits:** 3 Months (September- December, 2018); 16 credits

**Application fee: Rs 480 (Rs 190 for SC/ST/PwD)**
