BA in Global Studies (BA-GS)

The BA programmes at Karampura Campus, AUD offer students a unique liberal arts education that acquaints them with diverse approaches to knowledge. The undergraduate programmes at AUD offer students a wide choice of courses. The Programmes encourage students to think critically and creatively, to analyse and reason, to communicate effectively and to draw evidence-based conclusions. It aims to achieve a balance between the range and depth of the subjects studied.

The BA Programme in Global Studies (BA-GS) can best be described as an immersion in global thinking through interdisciplinary studies. The BA-GS programme offers students the opportunity to become proficient in a foreign language as well as the rare opportunity within Indian undergraduate education to develop a perspective that is increasingly informing employment and entrepreneurship opportunities.

The BA-GS programme will provide a well-rounded liberal arts degree that prepares students for a variety of careers and entrepreneurial opportunities in the inter-national arena. BA-GS graduates will bring to existing employment and entrepreneurial opportunities, the unique perspective and insights that are to be gained from also having studied the global dimension to local issues. Additionally, the BA-GS graduate will be equipped with the necessary skills (through language, data analytics, etc.) to both take advantage of the opportunities that come with change as well as become leaders of that change. By developing their abilities in reading, writing, analysis and critical thinking, BA-GS students will be ready to take advantage of academic, employment and other opportunities that are increasingly arising in a globalised world.

Structure

Students admitted to Global Studies will complete their core course requirement by choosing four core/elective courses from each of the following 3 streams: a) a single Foreign Language (at present, Chinese and French), b) Global Humanities and c) Global Political Economy.

The programme is delivered through a total number of 96 credits over six semesters. In order to receive a BA degree in Global Studies, these credits must be earned in the following manner:

Medium of instruction: English

Eligibility: The candidate must have passed the class XII or an equivalent examination from a recognised Board and secured the minimum cut-off marks prescribed by the University.

Fees:

Tuition fee of Rs.1,34,400/- (@Rs. 1400/- per credit i.e. Rs. 22400/- per semester) + Rs.5000/- (one-time, refundable caution deposit) + Rs.500/- per semester for student welfare fund.

If a student opts for extra credits, an additional fee of Rs.1400/- per credit will have to be paid.

Partial/Full fee waiver and scholarships are available. Full fee waiver of tuition fee will be extended to students belonging to SC/ST/PwD categories.

Selection procedure

The selection will be based on merit on the basis of the marks obtained in class XII, which will not include any vocational subject.

Reservations norms of Government of NCT of Delhi will apply.
