

HOSTEL

AUD has about 45 seats for women scholars at Kashmere Gate Hostel and about 35 seats for women at the Karampura campus. The students will need to make their own travel arrangement from Hostel to AUD Campuses.

INTAKE ADMISSIONS

Seats: 32 per vocational programme

ELIGIBILITY

Class 10+2 pass from CBSE or its equivalent from a recognised board or university

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Stage-I: On the basis of Class 12 marks (points) + Points awarded for vocational Subject + Marks secured in Vocational Aptitude Test (VAT). Short listed candidates will be called for an interview.

Stage-II: Offer of admission will be based on the cumulative score on all the 4 criteria of Class 10+2 marks, points awarded for vocational subject (recognized by State/ National Boards) in class 10+2, marks secured in VAT and the interview.

Weightage provided during admission is as per below:

i) Class 10+2 marks	40%
ii) Vocational subject in class 10+2	10%
iii) Vocational Aptitude Test (VAT)	25%
iv) Personal Interview	25%

FEE STRUCTURE*

- Tuition fee: Rs.800/— per credit. Semester 1 = 30 credits. Total tuition fee for each semester Rs.24000/-.
- Additional programme enrichment fees: Rs.1000/-per semester (may differ from semester to semester for different BVoc programmes) for Industry exposure, special seminars, practical and interactions with industry experts.
- Student Welfare Fund: Rs.500/- per semester.
- One time Caution/Security Money of Rs.5000/— (Refundable)

FEE WAIVER

Full and Partial fee waivers available to students based on economic background. Student with an annual family income of less than Rs. 6 Lakhs is considered for tuition fee-waiver. Full waiver of tuition fees extended to students belonging to SC, ST and PwD categories.

SVS has explored and developed programmes and courses that provides students with the required skill-set and academic background for meaningful employment. These programmes enable our learners to become self-employed, entrepreneurs, creators and generators of job for themselves and for many more educated youth in the society.

The BVoc programmes offered by SVS are unique because the curriculum for each vocational programme has been designed in consultation with industry experts, industry associations, Sector Skill Councils, various Schools and Centres of the University and National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) as well as professionals and academics.

SVS, following the University Grants Commission's (UGC) guidelines, offers multiple entry and exit options that lead to Certificate, Diploma, Advanced Diploma and Bachelor of Vocation (BVoc) degrees.

- The Programmes comprise two types of courses: (I) Skill oriented (theory & practical), and (ii) cluster of foundation courses (compulsory and elective) also known as General Education Component (GEC).

- The theory and practical component of the Skill Courses are transacted in AUD Campus and compulsory Industrial Internship in the concerned industry in each semester.
- The Industrial Internship is provided to students from Semester 1 to prepare them to be job ready.

The GEC curricula have been designed with the help of internal AUD faculty and experts drawn from institutions/NGOs. These are designed to empower the students' overall development in personal, social and work environments. The Language and Communication courses are specifically designed to improve the English language proficiency communication skills and prepare them adequately for employment opportunities.

Credits: 30 credits in a semester

Skill Courses: 18 credits per semester
General Education Component: 12 credits per semester.

Teaching Methodology

Skill and practicum courses are taught through a mix of methodologies - classroom teaching, workshops, field attachments, projects, lab work and online facilitation.

Medium of Instruction: English

Faculty

The programmes are delivered by highly qualified, experienced and dynamic faculty and professionals drawn from the respective industries.

Assessment and Evaluation

- Continuous assessment and evaluation strategy.
- Students are expected to attend the classes from day one along including the orientation session.
- Mandatory attendance policy of 75%. The penalties for low attendance may include mandatory grade cuts' based on a sliding scale of attendance shortfall, withholding of grade card/transcript or other actions.
- Passing the mandatory industry /field internship/on job training is prerequisite to be promoted from one semester to the next semester.
- 3rd Party Assessment and Certification by the Sector Skill Council or Relevant Industry Body.
