

ADVERTISEMENT FOR RECRUITMENT OF PROJECT TECHNOLOGIST

E-QUAL Project

(Enhancing Quality, Access and Governance of Undergraduate Education in India)

Applications are invited from suitable candidates for a temporary position on the European Union sponsored project (through the British Council India) titled “Enhancing Quality, Access and Governance of Undergraduate Education in India (E-QUAL)”, 2013 – 2017.

The project is being jointly undertaken by Ambedkar University Delhi with Jadavpur University, Shiv Nadar University, University of Hyderabad, University of Bologna and King’s College London. The project principally explores the development and deployment of Open Educational Resources (OER) and seeks to apply new learning technologies to undergraduate education in India in four areas – critical thinking, cultural studies, human ecology, and natural resource management and sustainable development.

The initial appointment is for a period of one year with possible annual renewal till up to May 2017.

Responsibilities: Providing technical support to Project members developing online learning modules and utilizing OER, assisting in creation of a repository of online learning modules and digitized learning resources, film-making of OER (pre-production, production and post-production) including audio and visual components, maintaining audio-visual equipment, creation of graphic/visual design content, troubleshooting with the IT infrastructure and web-based transactions of course material, assisting in administrative tasks of the Project.

Eligibility: B.E./B.Tech. *or* Bachelors degree in Media / Visual art / Visual communication with minimum three years of employment experience in Production houses or freelance film-making. Proficiency in using software applications namely Adobe Premiere Pro, Adobe Photoshop, Adobe After Effects, Adobe Illustrator and Audacity.

Desirable: Proficiency in English. Experience preferred in use of technology-enhanced learning such as MOOCs, OER, Moodle, Google Classroom.

Remuneration: Rs. 40,000/- per month (consolidated).

The University reserves the right to offer the post at a salary lower than that advertised, depending on the qualifications, experience and performance of the candidate.

How to apply: Provide (1) a **curriculum vitae** not exceeding two pages detailing educational and employment history; (2) a **letter** of not more than 300 words explaining why you believe you are particularly suited for the position. Item (2) should be a digital scan (pdf) of the letter bearing your written signature. The letter should also contain

names of two referees and their contact details.
