

## Ph.D. Psychology Entrance Exam and Interview 2021

There will be both objective multiple-choice questions (**Section A**, 40 questions, 40 marks) and subjective questions (**Section B**, 30 marks) in the Entrance Exam. The interview will be 30 marks.

For **Section B**, an applicant needs to attempt two 15 marks essay questions in Section B (15 marks each, total 30 marks)

I) One will be compulsory, on research methodology, and based on the applicant's reading of 3 papers:

- a) Wendy Hollway: In Between Internal and External Worlds: Imagination in Transitional Space
- b) Virginia Axline: Chapter 4 from Dibs In Search of Self
- c) Michael Kral and Kate Burkhardt: The New Research Agenda for a Cultural Psychology

II) For the second 15 mark question, the student has to choose any one between questions based on either of the following readings :

- a) Parin Dossa- The Body Remembers
- b) Honey Oberoi- Through Alleys and "Innerscapes": The City and the Psyche
