

1. Guidelines for Admission on the basis of Sports/CCA for Undergraduate Programmes

- a) The applicant is required to fill the online application form available on the AUD Admissions Portal.
- b) The applicant can apply in a maximum of only one Game/Sport.

Admission herein will be based on:

Category I : Direct admission without sports trial

Category II: Admission on the basis of Sports Trial.

Category I : Direct admission without sports trial

(Criteria for Marking of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate)

Sportspersons who have represented India in the under-mentioned Competition(s), recognized and funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) will be given Direct Admission without Sports Trial for the Game/Sport mentioned by AUD.

- a. Olympic Games by the International Olympic Committee (IOC)
- b. World Championship / World Cup by International Sports Federations (ISF)
- c. Commonwealth Games by Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF)
- d. Asian Games by Olympic Council of Asia (OCA)
- e. Asian Championships by International Sports Federations (ISF)
- f. South Asian Games (SAG) by South Asia Olympic Council (SAOC)
- g. Paralympic Games by International Paralympic Committee (IPC)

Category II: Admission on the basis of Merit Certificates and Sports Trial.

(Criteria for Marking of Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate)

- i. **Out of 100 marks, 40 marks will be considered for Certificates and 60 marks for sports trials.**
- ii. **The Sports Admission Committee of AUD shall:**
 - (a) Screen the application form uploaded by the applicant
 - (b) Verify original Merit/Participation Sports Certificate of the applicant.

(c) Conduct Sports trials with internal/ external experts

- iii. The applicant, as per their age must be eligible to participate in Inter-University Competitions for the next three years and should not be employed on Part-time / Full-time basis anywhere.
- iv. It is mandatory to submit an Undertaking on AUD format by the applicant at the time of admission stating that
 - a) he/she will play for the College and University during their Undergraduate Programmes of study. (Annexure I). He/she would also participate in the Inter College, Inter University, State, National and International sports tournaments.

a) Merit/Participation Sports Certificate

- All candidates who have not participated in any of the competitions listed in Category I will have to take Sports Trials for AUD admissions 2020-2021. The candidates must qualify for sports trials.
- At the time of filling the application form for AUD admissions, candidates also need to upload their Sport Certificates on the AUD admission portal.
- Applicant is required to upload Self-Attested copies of three Merit/Participation Sports Certificate. However, only the Highest Merit/ Participation Sports Certificate will be considered for Marking.
- Sports Certificate of Invitational / Open / Prize Money League / Ranking Competitions / Memorial will not be considered.
- Criteria for Marking of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate the Marks for different levels of Game/Sport Competitions are given in the table below
- Merit/Participation Sports Certificate of preceding three years will be considered from 01st May 2016 to 30th April 2020.
- The applicant must secure minimum 04 Marks in the Marking of the uploaded Highest Merit/Participation Sports Certificate to be eligible for Sports Trials.
- The admission of students under reserved category of sports will be provisional until the verification of sports certificates from the concerned issuing authority

- The applicant must secure minimum 30 Marks (50%) out of 60 marks (maximum) in the Sports Trial in order to be eligible for AUD admissions under Sports quota.
- After the sports trials are conducted, a merit list of candidates will be prepared and displayed on their official website.
- Any injury/ casualty caused to the applicant during Sports Trials shall be the sole responsibility of the applicant.

Allotment of Programmes

- The allotment of programmes to the eligible applicant shall conform to University regulations and shall be based on the preference of programmes as applied by the candidate at the time of filling the form. The allotment of the programmes may be finalized by the Sports/CCA Admission Committee of the AUD.
- In Case of Tie:** Applicants securing same marks in the same Game/ Sport and if eligible for admission in the same programme in a UG Programme, the issue may be resolved in the manner as follows
 - Applicant securing higher marks in sports merit will be given higher preference.
 - If there is a tie within the same category, the tie shall be resolved by considering the "academic merit" i.e. as per admission criteria of the concerned school and even then if there is tie, it will be resolved by the seniority in age i.e. date of birth of the candidate and such tie will be resolved by concerned school in which applicant applied for admission.
- The grievance related to allocation of marks for Merit/Participation Sports Certificate, Sports Trial and allocation of programme shall be redressed by the AUD Grievance Committee.

2. Guidelines for Admission on the basis of CCA for and Allotment of Undergraduate Programmes

- 40% marks on certificates of applicants obtained in the preceding three years and interview conducted by the CCA selection committee at AUD. The minimum

50% from this criterion will enable the candidate to be considered eligible for trial.

- ii. The CCA committee may follow the parameter of marking on certificates as follows:

At the levels of International, National-Government recognised and Inter-universities: 1st position 40, 2nd position 36, third position 30.

At the levels of State-government/ national- non-government/ Inter colleges: 24, 20, 16.

At the levels of District- government recognised/ State -non-government/ Inter colleges: 12, 8, 4.

- iii. The CCA Selection committee for each CCA areas will comprise of the members as follows:

- a. Dy. Dean of Students Services for CCA
- b. Faculty Co-conveners of each CCA area
- c. Faculty representative in each CCA area
- d.

- iv. 60% marks on trial in one of the CCA areas. The minimum of 50% from this criterion will be the qualifying marks.

- v. Applicant securing higher marks in CCA merit of each of the CCA area will be given higher preference.

- vi. If there is a tie between two candidates to have secured the top merit in two different CCA areas and these candidates looking for a place in the same programme, the tie shall be resolved by considering the "academic merit" i.e. as per admission criteria of the concerned school and even then if there is tie, such tie will be resolved by the CCA Committee in manner that these two applicants may get admission in one of the programmes from their preference list.

- vii. The grievance related to allocation of marks for Merit/Participation Sports Certificate, CCA Trial and allocation of programme shall be redressed by the AUD Grievance Committee.
