Guidelines for Sports Quota Admission (Supernumerary) in **2022-23**

There will be one seat under the Sports quota in each BA and MA programme. For admission under the Sports quota, the following criteria will be maintained.

1. Applicants under the Sports quota need to register on the official website of AUD (those who have registered for Common University Entrance Test (CUET) in case of UG programmes), similar to the AUD admission procedure for other candidates.
2. Benefits on the basis of Sports shall be given to candidates who apply for admission under the reserved/supernumerary category of Sports.
3. At the time of filling the application form for AUD admissions, candidates also need to upload their Sports related Certificates on the AUD admission portal.
4. There will be one seat allocated to the Sports quota in each BA and MA Programme offered by the University.
5. List of Undergraduate Programmes and the total number of seats under Sports Quota (Supernumerary) at AUD is mentioned in the Admission Brochure for 2022-2023.
6. Games/Sports considered for Admission on the basis of Sports

Team Games

Basketball(M&W), Cricket(M&W), Football(M&W), Handball(M&W), Kabaddi (M & W),Kho-Kho (M & W),and Volleyball (M & W)

Dual & Combat Sports

Badminton (M & W), Boxing (M & W), Table Tennis (M & W), Taekwondo (M & W)

Individual Sports

Athletics (M & W), Chess (M & W) Shooting (M & W) 10 Meter Air Pistol & 10 Meter Air Rifle

Other Sports and Games

Only distinguished eligible candidates who have participated in any International event or have won a position (1/2/3rd) in any National sports/ games (other than sports/ games mentioned above in the category of Team/ dual and individual categories) and are certified by the Government recognised federation will be considered.

7. Guidelines for Admission on the basis of Sports and Allotment of Programmes

Category I : Direct admission

Category II: Admission on the basis of CUET, Merit certificates and Sports Trial.

Category I : Direct admission

(Criteria for Marking of Merit/Participation Sports Certificate)

Sportspersons who have represented India in the under-mentioned Competition(s), recognized and funded by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS) will be given Direct Admission.

- a. Olympic Games by the International Olympic Committee (IOC)
- b. World Championship / World Cup by International Sports Federations (ISF)
 - c. Commonwealth Games by Commonwealth Games Federation (CGF)
 - d. Asian Games by Olympic Council of Asia (OCA)
 - e. Asian Championships by International Sports Federations (ISF)
 - f. South Asian Games (SAG) by South Asia Olympic Council (SAOC)
 - g. Paralympic Games by International Paralympic Committee (IPC)

Category II: Admission on the basis of CUET, MERIT certificates and Sports Trial.

- i. **25%** weightage will be given to the marks obtained through academic performance in CUET/Dr. B.R. AUD entrance examinations. **25%** weightage will be given to the marks calculated on the basis of aggregate of 3 certificates submitted by the applicants of three preceding years beginning from 01/07/2019 to 30/06/2022. Top 10 applicants (based on score obtained by adding **25%** weightage of CUET score and **25%** weightage of certificate score will qualify for the trials. Performance trial-cum-interview will have **50%** weightage of the total marks obtained.
- ii. The Sports committees may follow the parameter of marking on certificates as follows:

At the levels of International, National-Government recognized, and AIU (Recognized and funded by Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports and School Games Federation of India (SGFI)

1st position	40
2nd position	36
3rd position	30

At the levels of State-government/ State Sports Association/State Directorate of Education/ State School Boards / Inter colleges: (School Games Federation of India (SGFI)

1st position	24
2nd position	20
3rd position	16

At the levels of District - District Sports Association/ District/Zonal/Regional Directorate of Education/ District School Boards government recognized/ Inter colleges:

1st position	12
2nd position	8
3rd position	4

Note-- Sports Certificate of Invitational / Memorial / Open / Prize Money League / Ranking competitions will not be considered.

- iii. The Sports committee will supervise the sports admission.
- iv. 50% marks on trial in one of the Sports areas. A minimum of 50% of this criterion will be the qualifying mark.
- v. Applicant is required to upload Self-Attested copy of top three certificates secured for the Highest Merit/ Participation in any Sports / games to be considered for marking.
- vi. If there is a tie between two candidates to have secured the top merit in two different Sports areas and these candidates are looking for a place in the same programme, the tie shall be resolved by considering the "academic merit", i.e. as per admission criteria of the concerned school. And, even then if there is a tie, such a tie will be resolved by the Sports Committee in a manner that these two applicants may get admission in one of the programmes from their preference list.
- vii. The grievance related to the allocation of marks for Merit/Participation Certificate, Sports Trial and allocation of programme shall be redressed by the AUD Grievance Committee headed by the Dean SS and comprising of sports committee members.
