| <p>On January 24, 2023, Dr. B.R. Ambedkar University Delhi organised a Panel Discussion on the theme, 'Promoting entrepreneurship in Higher Education Institutions' on the occasion of the Fifth International Day of Education. This panel discussion was steered by panelists, Dr. Pushpendra Singh, Advisor, Entrepreneurship Development Cell (EDC) and Dr. Santosh Singh, Dean, School of Liberal Studies. This event was attended by Faculty, Staff Members, and students of the University.</p> <p>The discussion was focused on how Entrepreneurship can be promoted among Students, Faculty as well as staff at the University. In his opening remarks, Dr. Nitin Malik, Registrar of the University, mentioned that India was going through a paradigm shift in education with the National Education Policy 2020, which lays emphasis on the enhancing skills as well as entrepreneurship.</p> <p>Dr. Pushpendra Singh, stressed on the need for Disruption in mind set and this would happen if entrepreneurs innovate products according to the need of the country rather than copying the developed countries. Furthermore, he reiterated that there was a need to ensure the environment is taken care of while innovating new products for the masses. Universities could contribute to the Entrepreneurial ecosystem by organising an Idea Champion Award competition to encourage students to ideate and innovate.</p> <p>The second panelist, Dr. Santosh Singh, shared that Entrepreneurs need to break the barriers and create value. He shared how the Economist, Joseph Schumpeter talked about gales of creative destruction, and how it wasn't only important to encourage students of technology and management to develop mindset curriculum but also involve students of other fields including Social Sciences, Medicine, Philosophy etc. He discussed how a basket of courses or a single course could be included in the available basket of courses to be opted for during the different undergraduate programmes offered at the University.</p> <p>To sum up, the panel discussion was quite an eye opener for many of the attendees and the discussions encouraged the students to embark on the journey of an entrepreneur.</p> | | | |
