Dr B R Ambedkar University Delhi released its Admission brochure for UG and PG programmes for the Academic session 2020-21 on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2020.

Releasing the admission brochure, Prof. Anu Singh Lather, Vice Chancellor, AUD announced that in the Academic session 2020-21, AUD will be launching five new programmes. The new UG programmes are BVoc Accounting & Finance Programme and BBA. The PG programmes are MBA in Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Venture Development (IEVD) and MA (Hindi). AUD is also launching MPhil Disability Studies from this academic session. She also highlighted that the new programme reflects an intricate blend of need for skill development and social responsibility.

Prof. Anu Singh Lather, Vice Chancellor, AUD assured that as in the last academic year, despite being severely affected by the pandemic and the lockdown, the University has risen to the challenges and has successfully completed the academic year 2019-20 for AUD, this year too, the University will continue the teaching learning process with all necessary support to its students. She informed that AUD implemented need based special internet package reimbursement policy for its students in the last semester. The University will continue with the policy in this Academic year As well till the unsettling situation arising out of COVID-19 pandemic requires so.

Prof. Krishna Menon, Dean SHS and Prof. Anita Ghai highlighted the salient feature of the MPhil Disability Studies programme. Prof. S. S. Jena, Dean SVS explained how AUD has responded to the increasing demand of Accounting & Finance Programme and has designed BVoc programme in the area. Prof. Kartik Dave, Dean SBPPSE explained about the newly launched BBA and MBA programme. The contents of new launched MA (Hindi) was elaborated by Prof. Satyaketu Sankrit, Dean (SOL).

Dr. Santosh Singh, Dean SS elaborated about the various welfare measures of the University i.e. learning enhancement grant, fee waiver policy and student welfare fund etc. He said that AUD is



committed to the values of Dr B R Ambedkar and extends all possible help and support to its students.

Dr. Nitin Malik, Registrar, AUD said that the University is sensitive to the difficulties of students in the challenging time of COVID 19 pandemic. He conveys his assurance that the admission process will take care of these difficulties and ensure that the students will not be jeopardized by circumstantial issues. The admission process will be provisional to give equal opportunity to all the students to participate in the admission process sans any difficulty
