

REVISED RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR AWARD OF SCHOLARSHIP

Objective: This is an incentive scheme to encourage students to excel in their academic pursuits and perform better while pursuing their programme of study in the University.

SCHEME

- The University will institute a scheme of Scholarships for meritorious students equivalent approximately to 10% of the fees collected for the programme in question.
- The Scholarship scheme will be open to all candidates irrespective of whether they are receiving any other award under any other scheme of the University.
- This scheme will be applicable to candidates at the level of individual programmes.
- Students who form the top 20% of the class in terms of the grades secured by them in a given semester may be awarded '**Outstanding Performance Scholarship**' out of the 10% of the fees collected, whichever is lower.
- An amount of Rs.8000/- each will awarded as scholarship to the eligible students.
- The unutilized amount, if any left after awarding scholarships to students who become eligible, shall be transferred to the 'Student Welfare Fund' of the University.

ELIGIBILITY

This scheme will be available to:

- those candidates who are pursuing a programme of study at the Masters or Bachelors degree level, as the case may be.
- those students (except those in semester 1, where performance in entrance test will be considered) who pass all courses of the previous Semester with at least an overall grade of B+ will be eligible for being considered for the award of a Scholarship.
- In addition, students who have made significant improvement at least by 2 grade points in a given semester compared to the previous may be awarded '**Outstanding Progress Scholarship**' of an amount of Rs.8000/- each as a sign of recognizing their improved efforts.

Scholarship Committee

A scholarship Committee shall be appointed by the Vice Chancellor, for each School with the following composition:

- Dean of the School (chairperson)
- Programme Coordinator
- One faculty member from the programme of study
- One faculty member from another school of study.

The committee will make recommendation to the Vice Chancellor for the award of scholarships at the level of each School.
